Relevant activities might include work with school or other bodies of governance, involvement in social justice issues, senior care, child care, and community service work with organizations such as food banks, hospitals, churches, charities, libraries, animal welfare organizations, children's camps and clubs, etc.

Amount: \$750

Fully complete this application to apply for this scholarship. This application and accompanying documents must be submitted to your school's career centre by 3:00 pm on Friday, May 17, 2019. The successful applicant will be notified by August 1, 2019 and the award will be presented before August 15, 2019.

Applicants may receive only one Metchosin Foundation scholarship. Receiving non-Metchosin Foundation scholarships and financial awards does not disqualify the student from receiving a Metchosin Foundation scholarship.

Submit this application only if:

- You have lived for at least two years inside the boundaries of the District of Metchosin or Beecher Bay First Nation during your time in secondary education.
- You will be graduating from a BC secondary school in 2019 and have plans for postsecondary education or training.
- You are willing to have your name published in Metchosin Foundation communications.
