This scholarship will be awarded to a qualified Canadian applicant demonstrating concern for environmental issues. Volunteer work on environmental projects and relevant classroom projects will be a principle consideration. Projects might include work on recycling, ecosystem restoration, wild animal care, pollution reduction and remediation, renewable energy sources, etc.

Amount: \$750

Fully complete this application to apply for this scholarship. This application and accompanying documents must be submitted to your school's career centre by 3:00 pm on Friday, May 15, 2020. The successful applicant will be notified by August 1, 2020 and the award will be presented before August 15, 2020.

Applicants may receive only one Metchosin Foundation scholarship. Receiving non-Metchosin Foundation scholarships and financial awards does not disqualify the student from receiving a Metchosin Foundation scholarship.

Submit this application only if:

- You have lived for at least two years inside the boundaries of the District of Metchosin or Beecher Bay First Nation during your time in secondary education.
- You will be graduating from a BC secondary school in 2019 and have plans for post-secondary education or training.
- You are willing to have your name published in Metchosin Foundation communications.
