 - Sponsored and led a Wills and Bequests discussion.
 - Continued support for the work of the Metchosin Seniors Association and SIRC.
 - Staged our main annual fundraiser the Halloween Party and Dance.
 - Participated in Metchosin Day, where it was announced that MF is administering the Valerie Cochrane Memorial Fund in partnership with Pearson International College of the Pacific. Pearson College students
