



## **Moralea Milne – Sc'ianew (Beecher Bay) Community Scholarship 2024**

**This annual scholarship will be awarded to an applicant who is a member of the Sc'ianew (Beecher Bay) community.**

**Amount: \$1,000**

### **General Application Criteria**

- You are a member of the Sc'ianew (Beecher Bay) community.
- You have an interest in pursuing an educational program or learning opportunity to which scholarship funds would be applied.
  - Programs and opportunities can be related to, but are not limited to, personal or community well-being, career development, or environmental stewardship. Opportunities eligible for scholarship funding can include, but are not limited to, post-secondary education, certificate programs, courses and workshops, and internships.
  - Scholarship funds can be applied to tuition, fees, books, course-related supplies, transport, childcare and other related expenses.
- You are willing to have your name published in Metchosin Foundation communications if you receive an award from the Metchosin Foundation.

**Only one Moralea Milne – Sc'ianew (Beecher Bay) Community Scholarship is awarded per year.** Grade 12 students are given priority for this scholarship. If there are no Grade 12 recipients in a given year, then this scholarship is open to applicants of all ages from the Sc'ianew (Beecher Bay) community who are pursuing an educational program or learning opportunity.

**Applicants who are Grade 12 students:** This scholarship is open to Grade 12 students who are part of the Sc'ianew (Beecher Bay) community who are in their final semester of study and have an interest in pursuing an educational program or learning opportunity to which scholarship funds would be applied.

Applicants are requested to submit applications by or before 3:00 pm on Friday June 14, 2024, with the support of the Beecher Bay Band Designate for Community Support and

Development, the Band Social Development Manager, or their high school scholarship program coordinator.

Successful applicants will be notified by August 1, 2024 regarding award outcome and the award will be presented before August 15, 2024.

**Applicants who are not Grade 12 students:** If this scholarship has not been awarded to a Grade 12 student before August 1, 2024, then applicants of all ages who are part of the Sc'ianew (Beecher Bay) Community who are pursuing an educational program or learning opportunity may apply.

Applicants may apply between August 15, 2024 and November 15, 2024, with the support of the Beecher Bay Band Designate for Community Support and Development or the Band Social Development Manager. Applications must be received by or before 3:00 pm on Friday November 15.

Successful applicants will be notified by November 30, 2024 regarding award outcome and the award will be presented before December 31, 2024.
